

# Entry-Level Police Officer Hiring Process



## **Kankakee Police Department Kankakee, Illinois**

The Board of Police and Fire Commissioners of the City of Kankakee, Illinois is accepting applications for the position of police officer with the Kankakee Police Department.

**Salary:** \$49,937.33 - \$73,839.04 (10 years)

**Population:** 27,000 (approx.)

**Sworn Police Officers:** 68

### **All applicants must meet the following minimum requirements established by the City of Kankakee:**

- U.S. citizenship;
- No felony convictions;
- Valid Illinois-issued driver's license;
- Must be between 20 and 35 years of age (must be 21 years of age at time of appointment), unless otherwise exempt per state statute;
- High school graduate or GED equivalent;
- Completed an Associate's Degree – **OR** - a minimum of 60 credit hours at an accredited college, university or junior college;
- Possess a valid P.O.W.E.R. Test card issued by NIPSTA, Triton College, or Joliet Junior College within 12 months of the application deadline date (October 22, 2018) - **OR** - successfully complete a physical agility test (P.O.W.E.R. Test) after completion of the written exam on November 3, 2018.
- Must successfully complete a written examination and oral interview;
- Must successfully complete a background investigation, polygraph, psychological and medical testing;
- **Pay a \$35.00 non-refundable application processing fee.**

### **Submission of Application:**

Applications **MUST** be submitted online by **Monday, October 22, 2018 at 4:00 PM (CST)**. Faxed, e-mailed, mailed or dropped off applications will **NOT** be accepted. Applications submitted after the deadline will **NOT** be accepted. Only one application per person, per testing cycle will be accepted.

**Preference Points will be awarded for Military Experience:** 5 points for 1 year of active duty U.S. military service members with an Honorable Discharge. Form DD-214 must be submitted with application to qualify.
